Announcing spectacular Rosé SoirIN entertainment lineup At-home gala and musical fundraiser to support St. Boniface Hospital on May 28

WINNIPEG – May 11, 2020 – A stellar lineup of up-and-coming and established Canadian musicians – including Juno Award winners and nominees, buzz-worthy emerging artists, and a Broadway performer – will perform on Thursday, May 28, in Winnipeg's most exclusive music venue – your home.

- Andrea Macasaet Winnipeg-raised Filipina actor and Broadway performer;
- Olivia Lunny Winner of CTV's The Launch Episode 4.

"We're thrilled with the lineup of artists from across Canada," said Louis Trepel, St. Boniface Hospital Foundation Board Member and *Rosé SoirIN* Co-Chair. "Call it a curated mix of up-and-comers, local favourites, and established performers." Mr. Trepel is organizing the event with fellow Board Members Doug Stephen, of 529 Wellington, and Tom De Nardi, of Piazza De Nardi.
